The Foundation Program is ideal for:

This program is designed for students who would like entry into an Aspire undergraduate diploma program, leading to a bachelor degree, but have not completed an Australian high school year 12 or equivalent. It is also suitable for students who would like an introductory program before tackling a full diploma.

Highlights

The curriculum is designed by ICMS academic staff to incorporate the specific knowledge and skills identified as prerequisites for study in bachelor's degree. Students study at the ICMS City Campus and have full access to campus facilities. The teaching format is designed to familiarise students with the teaching style used in ICMS and to develop the learning skills required by this style of teaching.

English Proficiency Requirements:

IELTS: Overall 5.5; Writing 5.0; Speaking 5.0

Entry Requirements:

Complete the equivalent of Australian year 11 standard education and be at least 17 years of age at the commencement of the Foundation Program.

Delivery mode:

Face to face lectures + tutorials + supervised self-directed study. Students complete a total of 728 hours made up of small group classes and self-guided learning.
