Applying for a Scholarship with ICMS Aspire

- The Academic Scholarship is open to International students completing either year 12 studies or who took a gap year in 2022.
- By completing this application, you will be considered for the Academic Scholarship February 2023.
- For all scholarship applications, the presentation, content, relevance and creativity of the application and the
 academic merit of applicants will be considered. Applications close 5pm Tuesday 27 December 2022 and no late
 applications will be accepted.
- Applications can be submitted in hard copy to the Scholarship Board or via email to icmsscholarships@icms.edu.au.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Board led by the Chair of the ICMS Professional Scholarships Program.
- Initially a group of finalists will be chosen based on stages one and two of this application.
- Scholarship finalists will be required to sit a Panel Interview. Zoom will be offered if you are unable to attend in person.
- The final Scholarship winner will be chosen from the group of finalists, based on their interview and final year 12 results.

Value: UP TO \$12,000 tuition waiver*

Applications Due: 5pm Tuesday 27 December 2022 (for the February 2023 study period)

Application Process

Stage 1: Apply to Aspire Institute

All scholarship applicants must obtain an unconditional Letter of Offer from Aspire Institute to be eligible to apply. Please apply to Admissions: https://aspire.edu.au/apply/application

Stage 2: Application Form

Please complete the Application form.

Stage 3: Essay

Please complete a one-page essay about your business passion.

Stage 4: Submit Application

The following documents must be submitted with the Application form.

- English language proficiency
- Unconditional Letter of Offer from Aspire Institute Admissions Office
- Essay
- Last set of high school transcripts and/or trial results
- School awards & References (personal and/or work)
- Photo Headshot (School Photograph is acceptable)
- Copy of Passport

Stage 5: Panel Interview

Applicants will attend a Panel Interview by the Scholarship Board. The interview, which will be conducted at the ICMS campus in Manly, NSW or via Zoom if unable to attend in person, will be used to further ascertain the candidates' suitability.

Stage 6: Selection

The final scholarship recipient will be selected based on the results of stages 1 through 5 and final Year 12 results.

All interviews will be held on campus at ICMS, 151 Darley Road, Manly, NSW or via Zoom.

All applicants will be notified of the results by letter / email.

NOTE: Scholarship submissions will **not be returned**. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

Acceptance Procedure

Upon notification of being awarded the Academic Scholarship AFP, successful candidates are required to inform the College of acceptance or non-acceptance, in writing, within two working days of receipt of notification.



Terms & Conditions

- 1. The Scholarship Board's decision is final.
- All applicants must hold an International Passport.
- The scholarship value will be credited to the recipient's second study period. Therefore, in the first study period
 the recipient will be charged full fees and if all subjects are passed the appropriate fee waiver will be granted for
 the second study period academic fees.
- 4. This Academic Scholarship awards the recipient with a tuition waiver UP TO \$12,000.
- 5. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.
- 6. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high.
- 7. All scholarships awarded are subject to approval by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- 8. The deposit fee is to be paid as stipulated in the letter of offer, sent by ICMS Aspire.
- 9. ICMS Aspire scholarships are non-transferrable and not able to be deferred.
- 10. ICMS Aspire scholarships are not refundable and non-transferrable, meaning the scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
- 11. The scholarship must be redeemed for the intake date stipulated on the offer letter and scholarship agreement.
- 12. The recipient of the scholarship agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and rules and regulations prescribed by ICMS Aspire while enrolled.
- 13. Retakes or re-sits of a subject or subjects due to failing the subject are to be paid for by the student and are not included in the scholarship.
- 14. Once a student of ICMS Aspire, scholarship recipients will be required to contribute 8 hours* per week in one of the ICMS Aspire departments and also provide the marketing department with a photo, profile and have a willingness to participate in future marketing, blogging and college activities and act as an ambassador for their country.
- 15. The Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ICMS Aspire program.
- 16. Any persons deemed to have misrepresented themselves in their application through fraudulent documents or identity in the interview will forfeit the scholarship and lose their deposit.
- 17. The college reserves the right to change or cancel all or part of the scholarship program without notice.
- 18. Scholarship students will report to the Admissions Manager or Regional Development Manager (Australia) upon commencement at ICMS Aspire.
- 19. College fees and awards are subject to change.
- 20. Applicants must have an unconditional Letter of Offer to be eligible.
