Application Stages

- **Stage 1:** Apply to Aspire Institute Admissions to obtain Unconditional Letter of Offer (Required for Submission)
- Stage 2: Download and complete the scholarship application form
- Stage 3: Complete a One-page Essay about your business passion
- Stage 4: Submit your completed scholarship application.

The following documents must be submitted with the application form:

- Unconditional Letter of Offer from Aspire Institute
- English language proficiency (International scholarships only)
- Essay
- Last set of high school transcripts and/or trial results
- School awards
- References (personal and/or work)
- Photo Head Shot (School Photograph is acceptable)
- Copy of Passport

- Stage 5: Panel Interview
- Stage 6: Scholarship awarded to successful applicants

- 2. Academic requirements
- 3. Essay submission
- 4. Panel Interview Finalists will be contacted to arrange an interview either by phone, Skype or in person.

Terms & Conditions

- 1. All International applicants must hold an International Passport.
- 2. All domestic applicants must hold an Australian Passport.
- 3. The applicant is required to email their application including English Language Proficiency, academic proficiency to <u>info@aspire.edu.au</u>
- 4. All final applicants will be notified by ICMS Aspire within 10 working days after their Panel Interview.
- 5. The half scholarships will be credited to the recipient's second trimester. Therefore in the first trimester the recipient will be charged full fees and if all subjects are passed a full fee waiver will be granted for the second trimester academic fees.
- 6. The deposit fee is to be paid as stipulated in the letter of offer, sent by ICMS Aspire.
- 7. ICMS Aspire scholarships are non-transferrable and not able to be deferred.
- 8. The scholarship must be redeemed for the intake date stipulated on the Letter of Offer and scholarship agreement.
- 9. Recipients must be able to obtain a visa and arrive in Australia before their intake date or risk forfeiting the scholarship in its entirety.
- 10. The recipient of the scholarship agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and rules and regulations prescribed by ICMS Aspire while enrolled.
- 11. Once a student of ICMS Aspire, scholarship recipients will be required to contribute 8 hours* per week in one of the ICMS Aspire departments and also provide the marketing department with a photo, profile and have a willingness to participate in future marketing, blogging and college activities and act as an ambassador for their country.
- 12. Retakes or re-sits of a subject or subjects due to failing the subject are to be paid for by the student and are not included in the scholarship.
- 13. The Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ICMS Aspire program.
- 14. Any persons deemed to have misrepresented themselves in their application through fraudulent documents or identity in the interview will forfeit the scholarship and lose their deposit.
- 15. Scholarship students will report to the Admissions Manager or Regional Development Manager (Australia) upon commencement at ICMS Aspire.
- 16. The college reserves the right to change or cancel all or part of the scholarship program without notice.
- 17. College fees and awards are subject to change.
- 18. Scholarship value is subject to change in line with program and fee changes.
- 19. Applicants must have an unconditional Letter of Offer to be eligible.
