Fondly known as 'the castle on the hill' (where Hollywood blockbuster *The Great Gatsby* was filmed), our Northern Beaches Campus is a Sydney landmark dating back to the 19th century.

It is a five-minute walk to Manly's town centre, well known for its shopping precinct, cafés and restaurants, and world-famous Manly Beach. There's plenty to explore nearby – think harbourside bushwalks, snorkelling, surfing, and more. A few minutes' walk in the other direction leads you to the foreshores of the harbour where you can take a 17-minute fast ferry to Circular Quay.

As an Aspire Institute student, you will have access to many facilities, including our library, computer laboratories, tennis and basketball courts, café and bar. Free wi-fi is available throughout the buildings of the campus.

Australia is a great place to study. The Australian government has established laws to support international students, ensuring their safety and the quality of the education they are being offered. Aspire Institute has representatives in most countries throughout the world who can assist you with your application to study with us.

QUALITY ASSURANCE

Studying English in Australia means meeting global standards. Australia has a national regulatory and quality agency for international education called TEQSA (Tertiary Education Quality Standards Agency). This body is responsible for monitoring national standards for institutions such as Aspire Institute and ICMS.

ICMS has self-accrediting authority (SAA) in the Broad Field of Education (FoE) 08 Management and Commerce and Narrow FoE 1101 Food and Hospitality for Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) levels 5-9 (excluding research). Courses in the FoE 02 Information Technology are accredited by the Australian Government's Tertiary Education Quality Standards Authority (TEQSA).

Aspire English is also a member of English Australia and NEAS. English Australia is the national peak body for the English language sector of international education in Australia, ensuring that quality English language programs are delivered to international students. NEAS provides quality assurance for the English language teaching community.

GOVERNMENT SUPPORT

In Australia, international student rights are protected by the law under the Education Services for Overseas Students (ESOS) Act 2000. This includes protecting the wellbeing of international students, delivering a quality education experience, and the provision of up-to-date and accurate information. The ESOS Act also employs a Tuition Protection Service (TPS) for international students in the event that the institution is unable to teach your course.

GET QUALIFIED QUICKLY

At Aspire Institute, diplomas can be completed in eight months by selecting four subjects per trimester, rather than the standard one-year duration. This means you can get qualified with a diploma in just two study periods.

TRANSITION INTO 2ND YEAR OF A BACHELOR'S DEGREE

Aspire diplomas offer you a stand-alone qualification, or you can use the qualification to pathway into a bachelor's degree program at ICMS, or at one of the prestigious universities we partner with.

HOW IS A DIPLOMA DIFFERENT FROM A BACHELOR'S DEGREE?

A diploma qualification is essentially the first year of a three-year bachelor's degree. As an Aspire diploma student you will be welcomed into the wider ICMS student community, attending small classes alongside first-year bachelor's degree students. You will receive additional support and attention to ensure a smooth transition into a bachelor's degree, if that is your goal and you successfully complete your diploma subjects.
